Report of the Summer Section for the 2019 AGM

2019 May 20

For the 2018 summer section, at the start of the season 81 outings were proposed. Over the summer 9 more were proposed for a total of 90 outings. We tried to offer trail running, but all 4 of these outings were cancelled due to lack of interest. Many other outings were also cancelled due to injuries, bad weather, lack of interest, etc. In the end 68 outings took place. In these outings there were a total 770 participants. (The sum of the number per outing, not 770 *distinct* participants.)

10 238 CHF was taken in, of which 1655 CHF was the paid to the SCIG. (The rest was the 50 CHF per day paid to the outing leaders and hotel, rental, etc. costs.) We spent 1072.40 CHF for a dinner for our outing leaders, leaving a profit of 582.60 CHF

The largest number of participants per outing was 26 (one of mine \bigcirc) and the smallest number was 3 (one of Norayr's \bigcirc).

Norayr led 9 Via Ferrata outings!
