Boucle de Pététoz via Cols de Chavan & Vesinaz

Dimanche - Sunday 13 Oct., 2019 Moyen

A nice hike in the mountains for the day. From the Cols the mountain views are stupendous. From secluded valleys to alpine pastures, from a pass to a beautiful natural lake, you will appreciate all facets of mountain nature. You may see the grouse and, from a distance, chamois. From the parking in La Chèvrerie, we hike to the Chalet de Chavan, meet a very interesting Montagnard, Claudius living there, and then ascend to the Col de Chavan (1745m). For those energetic hikers, there is a short jaunt up to the Haute Pointe (1958m) un point de vue extraordinaire. From the Chalet

we traverse a diverse path of alder forest and a rocky slope till we reach Col de Vesinaz. Another splendid view. Our descent includes passing by Lac Petetoz and returning through the forest to the car park.

<u>Accumulated Elevation gain approx</u>.: 1179 (if to Haute Pointe – otherwise 848m; <u>Max/Min elev</u>. 1958/1100m <u>Length</u>: 11km, <u>Hiking Time</u>: 5+hrs with stops to enjoy the views.
