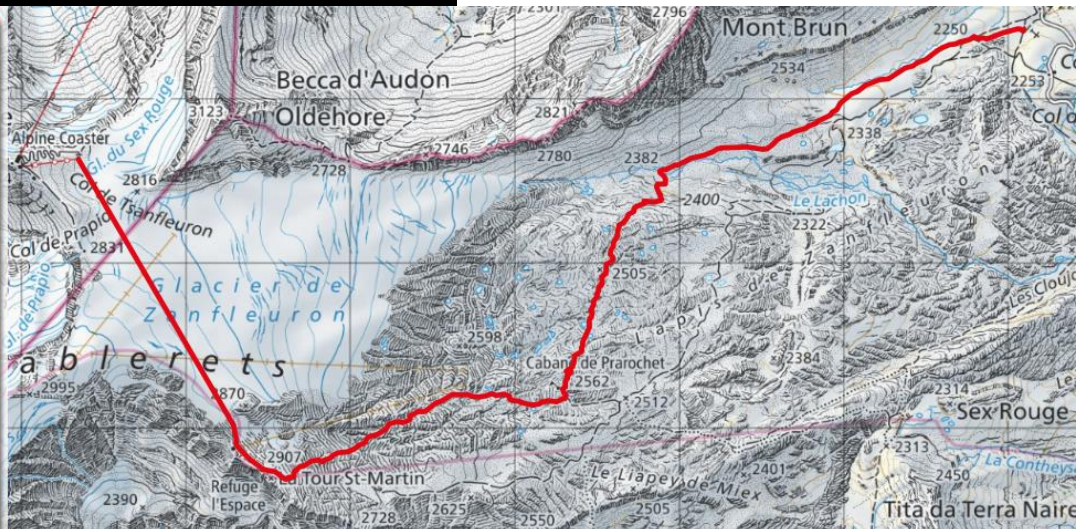


INTERNATIONAL SKI CLUB OF GENEVA (SCIG)

SUNDAY, 2020 OCTOBER 4 – MOYEN/DIFFICILE – VALAIS

From Col du Sanetsch we cross fun lapiaz to the Cabane Prarochet, walk on beautiful glacially polished limestone with fossils to the Quille du Diable at the Refuge l'Espace, cross (very safely) the Glacier de Zanfleuron to Glacier 3000 and take the cable car down. There are views of the Alps.
