



To Bring: mask, good boots, hat, picnic lunch, water, warm coat, rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses, Euros, collapsible ski pole(s) optional. In addition, bring your national passport and proof of vaccination (or negative COVID test).

Rendezvous: 8:30 for a 9:00 departure

Place: Parking near the Salle Communale de Chêne-Bougeries; 1, route du Vallon.

By car: take the Route de Chêne towards Chamonix. Following the signs for Chamonix, turn right onto Route du Vallon. The parking area is on the left in about 200 m.

By tram: take tram 12. Get off at Grange-Falquet. Walk 200 m further; turn right onto Route du Vallon. The parking area is on the left in about 200 m.

Price: CHF 5 club tax (**CHF 15 for non-members.**) Plus **CHF 20** to be paid per person directly to the driver. The driver pays the motorway tolls (3.80 € round trip).

Maximum altitude: 1,863 m

Elevation gain: about 800 m **Round-trip:** 9.2 km

Walking time: About 2 to 2h30 going up. Less than 2 hours going down.

Transport: private cars (9h00 – 15h30)

Confirmation or cancelation of the hike:

If the weather is bad, I will cancel. The afternoon before the hike, I will send an email to confirm or cancel.

Advice to drivers: Drive on A40 heading to Chamonix. Take Exit 15 just after the toll plaza and head to Peillonex. Follow navigator and head to Saint-Jean-de-Tholome. Follow the road past the town and up to the mountain for about 10 km. It ends at the parking lot of the trail head. There is a resto there where we can have coffee and croissant if that is what the group wants. Toilet also available. We can also have drinks at this resto after the hike.



- **By registering, you agree that you are fit for this level of hike and/or that you have previously participated in a difficult hike with the SCIG.**
- **By registering, you confirm that you carry insurance against accidents and mountain rescue, including helicopter rescue. (For example REGA: <https://www.rega.ch/en/home.aspx>) Check with your employer to see if you are properly insured. *The Hike Leader and the SCIG disclaim any and all liability for accidents related to this hike.***
- ***In the cars we will wear masks. During the hike we will maintain 2 meters of distance.***
