A walk on the Compostelle de St Jacques from St Blaise to Croix de Rozon



Walk Details: Length: 12km; Hiking Time: 4-5h (depending on our speed), Max altitude: 785, Elevation Loss: 410m

A chance to experience one stage of the Camino or Compostela de St Jacques, walking from St Blaise to Croix de Rozon/Collonges-Sous-Salève and for the hardier, to Carouge or Geneva. This is a beautiful hike, mostly downhill all the way, following the contours of the Salève, with views of Geneva before us. This hike covers a variety of the paths, through the Forest of Pomiers, passing the Chartruese Chateau de Pomier, fields and villages.

This is an easy walk, good for the soul by getting some fresh air and some sunshine (weather permitting).

TRANSPORT: Bus T72. A French bus company, www.Transalis.fr

The BUS is scheduled Geneva Airport to Annecy – via only a few selected stops en route, such as Charmilles, Suejet, etc.

MEETING POINT: Either at my bus stop, at Charmilles (BUS stop across the street from the Pharmacy) at 08:35 (Be there at 08:20 am) Or on the BUS. You must confirm to me exactly where you will catch this bus.

You buy tickets on the bus. Return by TPG BUS. There are bus connections at Croix de Rozon for Geneva.

COST: You must buy your own bus tickets.

IMPORTANT!

Insurance: Accident insurance obligatory (REGA). SCIG does not provide collective accident insurance to participants.

Cancellation: In the event of bad weather, or insufficient participants, the hike will be cancelled. All participants will be notified by GO/NO GO decision by email, latest Friday midday or early eve, (22 Nov).

Withdrawal: In case of withdrawal, please inform the hike leader no later than Thursday evening, 17:00.

To Bring: Appropriate clothing, good boots, sun hat, picnic lunch, water, spare warm layer, waterproof rain gear, sun screen, sun glasses. Walking poles (if you use them). Swiss francs/Euros
