of descent. It will take approximately 6.5 hours with stops. There is an exposed section and a couloir with cables, chains and staples; sure-footedness, an ability to hike in mountain terrain and lack of vertigo are a must. *Please do not overestimate your ability; any hiker significantly behind the others or who cannot pass the exposed section and couloir will unfortunately be asked to turn around and wait at the trail head (this includes drivers as a courtesy to their passengers). Please email the leaders with questions beforehand!
