Caroline will meet the group in Aigle for the train departing at 09:29 to Le Sépey. From Le Sépey we will take bus B175 to La Comballaz, centre.

To bring: hiking boots, **snowshoes**, collapsible hiking pole(s), snack, water, hat, warm clothes, sunscreen and sunglasses.

Buy your train ticket individually in advance: Geneva to La Comballaz, Centre return. We will aim to return on the 16:39 bus from La Comballaz, centre. This will get participants to Geneva at 19:10.

Maximum altitude: 1,710 m

Elevation gain/ loss: ±440 m

Distance: 9 km
