LES PERTES DE LA VALSERINE SUNDAY 2024 JUNE 2 - FACILE - AIN

We visit spectacular potholes, a waterfall, and a cave.



We take a train to Bellegarde-sur-Valserine, France (363) to hike the Perte de la Valserine trail. We descend to the Métral dam and its abandoned hydroelectric plant built in 1870, and a nice waterfall. There the Valserine river flows smoothly. We continue upstream for a few minutes to the Perte de la Valserine, which has dozens of impressively big and small potholes. We cross the Pont des Oules ("oules" means big potholes) in the centre of the big potholes. There the river is flowing





violently through a narrow gorge. Then we walk through a magical forest where the tree trunks are completely covered with moss. We continue to the Grotte de Bramabœuf. After bending over to enter it, it is narrow but high enough to walk easily. After a few meters there was another low spot where you have to crouch quite down, then it goes on. It is wet with active stalactites. We reverse our route back to Bellegarde.
