## CABANE DES BECS DE BOSSON

SATURDAY-SUNDAY 2024 JULY 20-21

VALAIS – MOYEN/DIFFICILE

We will have stunning 360° views of almost all of the high Alps. From the top of the Bendolla cable car, we hike across a somewhat rocky ridge and ascend to the Pas de Lona. We ascend a ridge that often has edelweiss to the Cabane Becs de Bosson, where we will sleep. The next morning before breakfast we watch the sunrise from Pointe de la Tsevalire (3026). After breakfast we ascend (optionally – it's quite tricky) Becs de Bosson (3149). We descend, cross the Basset de Loma pass, descend to the beautifully azure (with glacial milk) Lac de Moiry, barrage and take the buses & trains home.

**Return:** Bus from Moiry Barrage 14:18, **16:39**, 17:39, then about 4 hours to Geneva




## Day 1


Length 7.31 km
