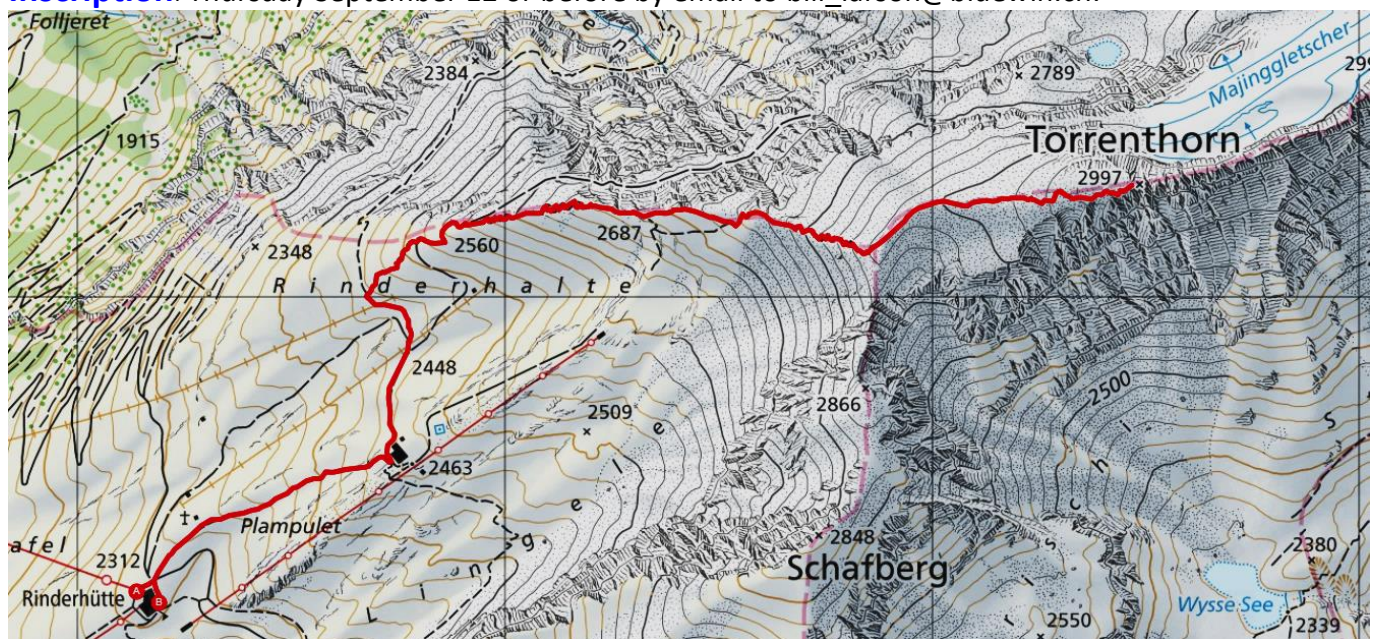
## TORRENTHORN (2997)

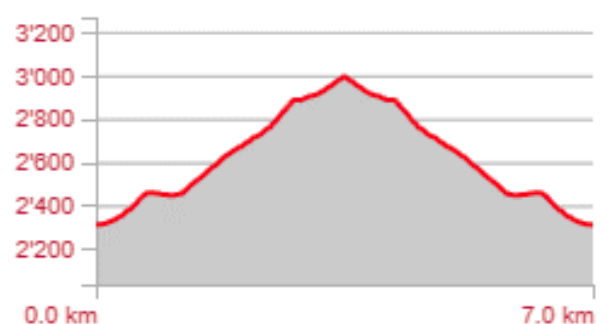


### I need to know:
