From Noiraigue we walk through forest paths to the very impressive semi-circular cliffs of the Creux du Van. There are also views of the Alps.

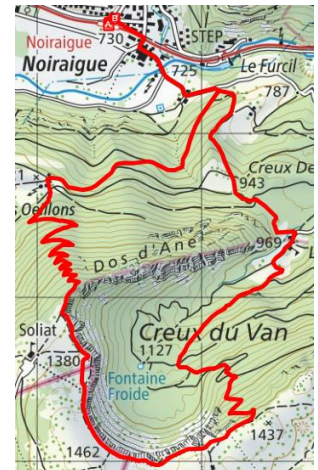
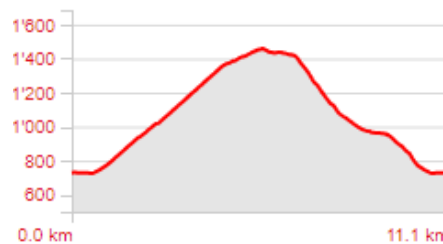
