## CABANE DE PETIT PÂTRE

*FRIDAY 2024 DECEMBER 27 – DIFFICILE - HAUTE SAVOIE*

**This raquette hike involves a relatively short but steep hike up to 1900 metre vantage point with 360 degree views of several mountain ranges.**

A strenuous hike for those who need to get out and enjoy the mountain air after the Christmas dining season. From the Du Peray car park we climb through a shaded steep trail for about 400 metres until we reach the beginning of a plateau. At some point on the ascent we will put on our showshoes/raquettes which are obligatory for this hike. From here the views gradually become breathtaking, arising onto a promontory, with views in every direction over the Arve valley, and the Aravis, Fiz and Mont Blanc massif ranges.



Then there is a gently sloping track up another 300 metres of elevation, over about 4 kilometres, with views all around if the weather is clear. We arrive at the Petit Pâtre cabin, ideal for lunch and can also serve as shelter. No exposed sections and nothing technical other than using snowshoes on relatively steep terrain. The start point for the hike is Parking Du Peray.

### **I need to know:**

- Your first and last name.
- Do you have a car and if yes, how many people can it contain, **including the driver?**
- An email address you can read on the weekend
- Your mobile phone number.
- Are you fit enough to walk for 5 hours at normal speed including the extra exertion of walking in snowshoes.
- What hiking or other sports have you done this year?
- Are you a SCIG member?

**To bring:** water/tea/coffee in an insulated container that will not freeze, picnic, snacks, waterproof hiking boots with winter hiking socks, snowshoes/raquettes, warm winter waterproof/windproof hiking gear, warm mid-layer, sunscreen, sunglasses, hiking pole(s) highly recommended. Gaiters recommended but not essential. The hike is in France.



**Rendezvous Place:** Parking near the Salle Communale de Chêne-Bougeries Rte du Vallon 1.

**By car:** take the motorway towards Chamonix, then exit for sallanches, then go to Cordon and Parking Du Peray – I enter Parking Du Peray into google maps

**By tram:** take tram 12. Get off at Grange-Falquet. Walk 200 m further; turn right onto Route du Vallon. The parking area is on the left in about 100 m.

**Time:** Meet 8:00 for an 8:15 departure

**Price:** CHF 5 (15 CHF for non-members), plus 20 CHF to be paid by each passenger to the driver. (0.20 CHF per km)

**Maximum participation:** 18 people depending on numbers of drivers

**Maximum altitude:** 1900 m

**Elevation gain & loss:** .650 m but feels more with snowshoes on

**Walking time:** About 5 hours

**Transport:** private cars

**Advice to drivers:** Straightforward using google maps to parking du peray close to Cordon
