La Sarraz-Croy-Romainmôtier (VD)

Two waterfalls and an ancient abbey!

Itinerary: Train to La Sarraz. Quick coffee or visit. Walk along the Venoge to Tine de Conflens (waterfall), where the Venoge meets the Veyron. Then we go up to Ferreyres, through the village, then down into the Gorges du Nozon to the Dard waterfall. Up to Croy, where those wishing to shorten the walk may take the train back. Otherwise, we walk on to Romainmôtier (40 minutes there and back, all flat) to see the ancient abbey and/or have tea.

About 3.30-4 hours actual walking time, 11 km (10 km to Croy), +310m, -160m.

Easy, but some steep ups and downs, slippery in the gorges.

To bring: boots, poles (recommended), water, picnic, warm, waterproof clothes.
