We then continue through meadows before beginning a steep climb to the Arête de Saix (1851m) which takes another hour approximately. We will picnic here, overlooking Mont Blanc. After lunch, we follow a path, steeply at first but which then becomes a balcony walk with impressive cliffs on the right. We reach the Chalet de Mayères after about 45 minutes and then follow a woodland walk back to the car park.
