To Bring: good boots, hat, warm layer, rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses 1 or 2 collapsible hiking poles (optional)and luggage with clothes and toiletries for 4 days. Pack this luggage separately. We will leave this luggage in a locker at the train station.


Price: 20 CHF for members (60 CHF for non-members), <u>Plus:</u> Your hotel, train tickets, and meals. **Buy your train tickets individually before departure:** Geneva to St. Moritz round trip

Your hotel should give you a voucher for a guest Premium Card for all buses, trains and cable cars in the St. Moritz area. Be sure to get this <u>IN ADVANCE</u>. (It will take about an hour to get it, because there are lots of hoops to jump through.) Françoise is preparing instructions. Then it has to be converted to a card at a lift station.

Rendezvous: Thursday September 11 at 6:55 am Geneve train station Track 4 for a 7:05 departure. Bill and Françoise will board at 7:40 in Renens.

Transport: Train, bus, and cable cars **Maximum number of participants:** 16

- By registering, you agree that you are fit for this level of hike and/or that you have previously participated in a difficult hike with the SCIG.

We drop our luggage in a locker at the St. Moritz gare on quay 1. We take the bus to St. Moritz Bad, Hallenbad or St. Moritz Bad, Post. There are several busses. Then we walk in an old Swiss stone pine forest and reach Muottas da Schlarigna with views over Lake St. Moritz and the surrounding mountains. Then we walk down to Pontresina, where we take the train back to St. Moritz.

Day 2 Coaz Hut We meet at the Surlej,

Corvatschbahn bus stop at 7:54. We get our vouchers converted to a cable car card. This will take some time. We must take the first Corvatsch lift at 8:25 to the midstation, Murtèl. We walk an easy trail to the Fuorcla Surlej Hut with a spectacular view of the glaciers descending from Piz Boval. We take a long trail eventually seeing the beautifully azure Lej da Vadret (Glacier Lake). We continue to the Coaz hut with stunning views many glacier-clad peaks. We reverse our route to Murtèl. This is a long hike (18 km) the last descent from Murtèl is 17:05. If necessary, we will cut the hike short.

Day 3 Boval hut

We take the 8:48 train from St. Moritz to Morteratsch gare. We hike to the Boval hut. Almost all of the time there is an increasingly spectacular view of the huge Morteratsch glacier and other glaciers descending from magnificent summits.

We take the train to Bernina Diavolezza, Bahnhof and then a cable car to Diavolezza (2974), where there is a stunning view of Piz Bernina and of the Pers and Morteratsch glaciers below and above us. Then we hike, sometimes across boulder fields, to Munt Pers (3207).
