27 SEPTEMBER 2025 – EASY

We will spend a day exploring Fribourg with an excellent virtual reality tour and stretch our legs on an easy hike in the Gorges of Gottéron afterwards.

Saturday, 27th September 2025 (9km, +320m/-320m, 2.5 hours) – Easy – Virtual Reality Tour of the City Centre of Fribourg and Gorges du Gottéron



We will have a leisurely start to the day and take the 8:54 train from Geneva to Fribourg. Once arrived, we will make our way to the tourism office near the station, where we will pick up our VR experience kits and explore the historic old town of Fribourg.

We will pass through the beautiful cathedral and discover what Fribourg (virtually) looked like in the year 1606. We will have a restorative lunch break and stretch our legs on a short hike through the Gorges du Gottéron, where a dragon was rumored to live in medieval times. The trail is well maintained and starts and finishes in the city centre of Fribourg. From here on, you can stay in Fribourg for a drink or make your way back to Geneva at your own leisure. We will finish around 4.30pm to 5pm.
