
INTERNATIONAL SKI CLUB OF GENEVA (SCIG)

GRUYÈRES TO LES PACCOTS OVER THE MOLÉSON SUNDAY 28 SEPTEMBER 2025 - MEDIUM

We will start in the beautiful medieval village of Gruyères and hike via the Moléson's great panorama to Les Paccots

17 km, +900m/-1000m, 7 hours





We will take the train from Geneva to Gruyères. From here we will have some time to explore the old town and castle for those of you that are interested. There are ample of options for a coffee as well or a visit to the HR Giger Museum of Giger's surrealist art.

We will start our hike around 10.30 with a steady climb through the foothills of the Moléson to the cable car middle station at Plan-Francey.

We will pass alpine meadows, forests and alps offering cheese and other produce along the way. The autumn colours will be slowly starting to show and lend the area a particular charm. We will take the cable car up to the peak of the Moléson, which is our high point for day.

After our lunch at the summit restaurant, we will follow the Moléson ridge line for excellent panoramic views and slowly descend towards Les Paccots with changing views of Lake Geneva, the Jura mountains and the Alps in all directions. After around three hours we will reach Les Paccots. Time allowing, we can grab a drink here before we head back to Geneva on the 18:17 bus.

Return Journey: We will travel back from Les Paccots with the 18.17 bus to Chatel St Denis and onward trains to Geneva. You will be back in Geneva around 8 pm.
