- Have you joined a similar hike (approx. 500 m gain and loss, about 9 km long with some technical segments)?

To bring: 1.5 litres of water (no water points on trail), picnic, good hiking boots, wool hat and gloves, warm jacket and scarf, rain gear, sunglasses, as well as collapsible hiking poles (recommended).

Transport: We will meet at 0900 for a 0915 departure by car at the parking lot near the Salle Communale de Chêne-Bougeries, Route du Vallon 1.

Club fee: CHF 5 for SCIG members and CHF 15 for non-members (TWINT preferable in either

case).

Maximum participation: Three cars or 15 persons max (Hike leader will drive one car with four persons).

In case of bad weather: The hike will be cancelled in case of inclement weather. I will send a confirmation email the day before the hike.

Hike info: A loop hike of approximately 9 km with a gain and loss of +/- 500 m. Our highest point is 919 m at the Belvédère de la Colonne. The trail takes us up through relatively narrow paths with views of the lake,

along the Grande Roche and les Fècles ridge. Some sections are steep and slightly technical, particularly around the Belvédère (secured passage). We will have our picnic at the Belvédère with panoramic views. Duration: approximately 4 hours.
