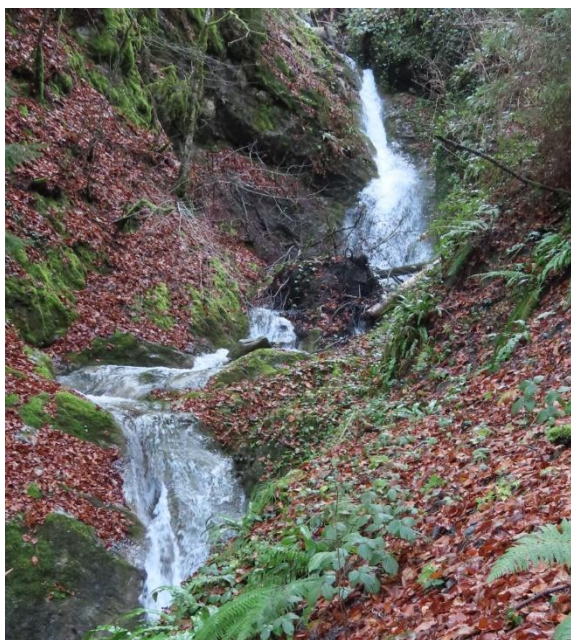
I need to know:

- 4) An email address you can read on the weekend.
- 5) Your mobile phone number.

To bring: water, picnic, snacks, boots, hat, sweater, rain gear, sun screen, sun glasses, and collapsible hiking poles (optional).

Buy your train ticket individually in advance: Geneva to Montreux and Les Avants to Geneva

Rendezvous: at 8.30 at Cornavin train station on platform 4. Take the second car from the back of the train. **8:39 departure.** Bill and Françoise will board at 8:55 in Nyon. We arrive in Montreux at 9:50



Price: CHF 5 club tax (CHF 15 for non-members) plus for train tickets to be bought individually in advance.

Maximum participation: 20 persons **Length:** 5 km

Maximum altitude: 970 m **Elevation gain:** 660 m

Elevation loss: 80 m **Walking time:** About 3 hours
