


Whoever was able to spot a bear before setting off was lucky. From the bear park, you descend through the forest towards Schwellenmätteli, where the Aare flows over the wide thresholds. Along the Aarstrasse underneath the imposing iron Kirchenfeld bridge you reach the Dählhölzli animal park. The domes of the government building gleam high above the river and the baths. Past the animal enclosures, the route continues on a wide riverside path upstream towards Eichholz - and finally out of the city. Ibex, beavers, flamingos and other animals populate the last enclosures along the Aare path before you reach the floodplain woods. Repeatedly, you walk along newly created side arms that provide space for small-scale flooding and a variety of habitats for beavers, amphibians...
