Possible return times: 15:40, 16:40 (last), then 2:21 hours to Geneva

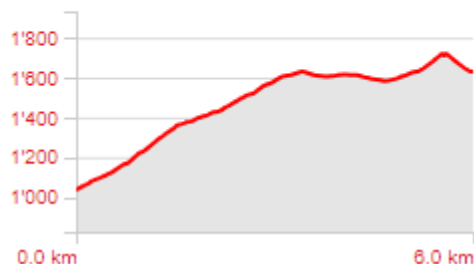
In case of bad weather: If the forecast is bad, we will cancel. I will send an email with my decision midday the day before the hike.
