A circuit which takes us from the Col, heading north-east, following the ridge of the Jura to reach the Club Alpin Suisse cabin at Cunay, having climbed Grand-Cunay (1602m) en route. From the cabin we turn east and descend for a while before turning towards the south-west to take the route back to the Col. This circuit takes us through woods and pasture land and has wonderful views both across to the Alps and to the Jura valleys. The route is largely flat but it is relatively long and requires 4.5 - 5 hours of walking.
