COL DU MARCHAIRUZ SATURDAY 25 FEB 2023

We start at the Col du Marchairuz and follow the descending route to the Ferme des Pralets, which is only accessible to skiers and hikers in the winter. On the edge of a pine forest, this mountain pasture chalet, typical of the Jura with its large galvanised metal roof, is nestled between the peaks of Mont Sâla and Mont Pelé. There's a small restaurant and terrace to make the most of your visit. It is possible to ski on to La Givrine, but the group will return by the same route ascending to Combe des Amburnex.

At the time of writing this flyer, snow conditions were excellent from le Marchairuz, Combe des Amburnex. Both classic and skating are possible. Hopefully, now that it has started snowing it will continue and the temperature will continue to be below zero. There are longer and shorter possibilities. Please let me know your experience level when you register. You must have some experience and feel comfortable going up and down slopes. The distance is anticipated to be 19.5km.

Transport by train and bus: Meet at Cornavin to depart Geneva 8.50 train to Allaman arrive 9.18 bus depart 9.25 arrive Le Brassus, Combe des Amburnex 10.13. Return bus: Le Brassus, Combe des Amburnex depart 16.44, train: Allaman 17.41 arrive Geneva 18.10.

Equipement: ski de fond classic or skating, sunglasses, sun cream, picnic, hot drinks, hat, spare clothes. Note that it is not possible to rent equipment at Le Marchairuz.
