La Foret de La Frasse (Massacre)

The forest of La Frasse or Massacre, extended to the north by the Massif des Tuffes, covers the top of the anticline located between the Combe du Lac and the Valserine valley. The average altitude is 1,350 m, with the highest point at 1,495.3 m, the highest peak in Franche-Comté. On the D25 road, from La Cure, the car park facing the Frasse forest road is 2 km from the Darbella, in the direction of Lamoura. Set off on the Dolarde piste towards the Darbella for a good kilometre, then climb up to the Chalet de la Frasse, for a coffee or hot chocolate.

From there, the slope then increases significantly to reach, after 1.5 km of effort, the Goulet crossroads. You are now in the heart of a high-altitude spruce forest, remarkable for the size, beauty and columnar shape of the spruce trees that compose it. The trail enters the Combe à la Chèvre, the entrance to which is marked by its summer chalet facing the Dôle. A few more efforts to reach the crest of the combe and the long descent of the Regarde will allow you to take a breather as you cross this magnificent alpine area, opening to the Bois Vert. Continue along the ski paths until you reach the Goulet crossroads and then to go down by the same track as on the outward journey. Back to the Chalet and then onto the parking.
